Conditions

1. Cost of shipping will be charged to the borrowing organization listed above at approximately \$100 per Quilt Section.
 - a. Cost of return shipping is the responsibility of the borrowing organization.
2. All Quilt Sections must be returned within 2 weeks of the end of the event.
 - a. A tracking number must be received by the National Coordinator for the return shipment of the section(s) by 2 weeks after the end of your event.
 - b. Failure to provide the tracking number or return the section(s) in person to the Canadian AIDS Society head office within the allotted time will result in a \$20 penalty at the beginning of each new week, to a maximum of \$400.
3. All Quilt Sections will be inspected for damage prior to shipping to your location, and any damage will be noted in the log.
 - a. Any new damages noted upon return of the Quilt Sections will result in fines for cleaning/repairs of the Section(s)
 - i. \$120 for cleaning
 - ii. \$75+ for repairs (price scales with amount of damage)
4. Photos of the display of each Quilt Section should be sent to quilt@cdnaids.ca and include details pertinent to the photo (section number, location of display, etc.)
5. Respect must be paid to the Quilt at all times during the showing:
 - a. Do not step on the Quilt Section(s)
 - b. No food or drinks near the Quilt Section(s)
 - c. Do not place the Quilt Section(s) on soiled surfaces.
 - d. The public should not touch the Quilt Sections.
 - e. Personnel handling the Quilt Section(s) for display or packing are asked to ensure their hands are free of residues before handling the section
